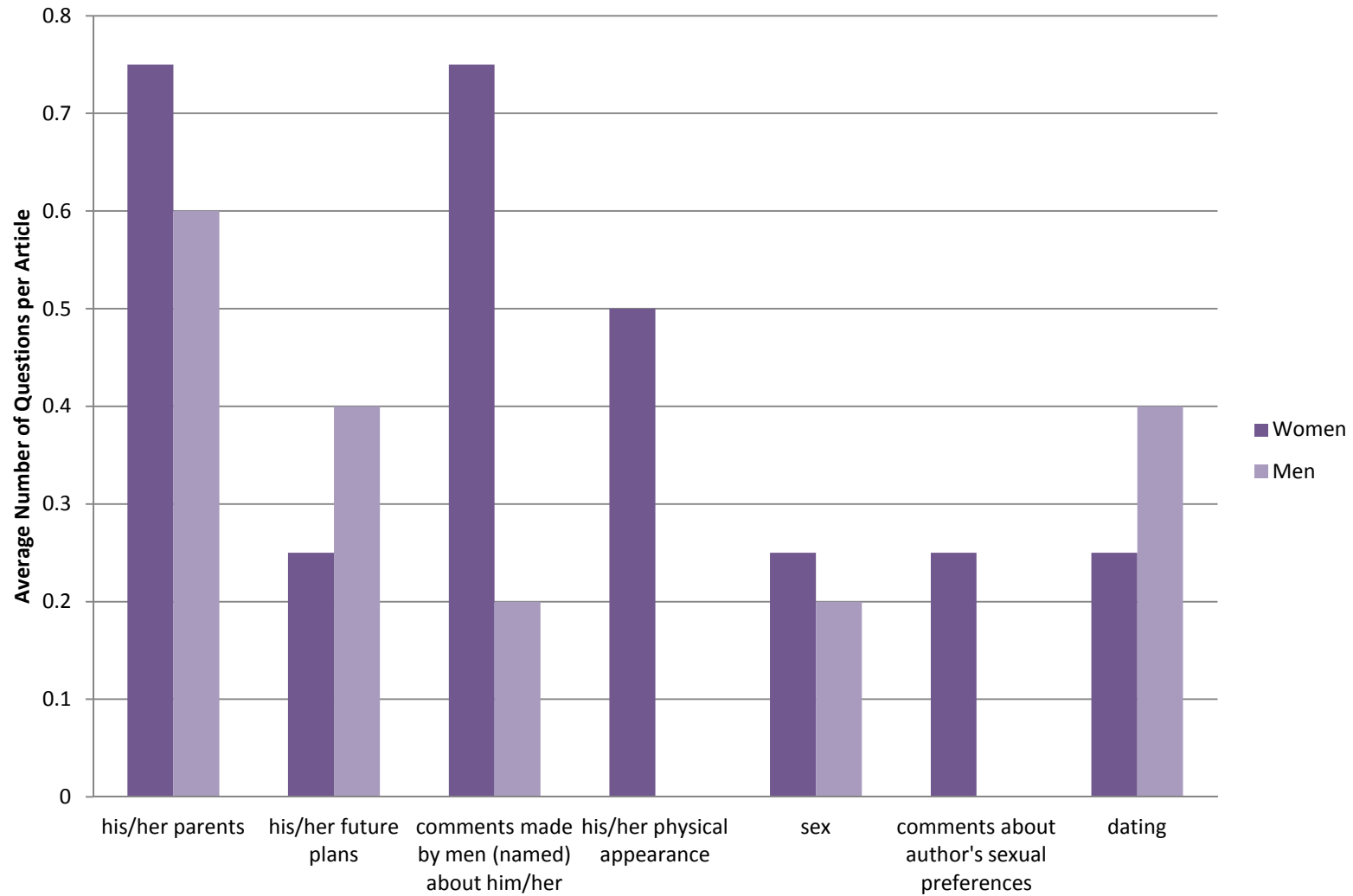


Andrew Goldman's Questions About...
